

Sex (Sex Assigned at Birth)

Categories (often seen as male or female) to which people are typically assigned at birth based on physical characteristics (e.g. genitals). Some people may be assigned intersex, when their reproductive, sexual or genetic biology doesn't fit the traditional binary definitions of male or female.

Attraction

A person's **romantic** and **physical** attraction to others. It can change and may or may not be the same as a person's sexual behaviour.

Gender Identity

A person's internal sense of identity as female, male, both or neither, regardless of their sex.

Gender Expression

How a person expresses their gender. This can include how they look, the clothes they wear, the name they choose, the pronouns they use (e.g., he, she, zie, zim) and their social behaviour.

Each person's sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression are a part of who they are and are unique to them.
