Femme Contour

How to look Femme

- Contour with a shade two to three shades darker than your skin across your jaw, nose, cheeks, and temples.

To make the face look softer rather than sharp.

- Dust cheeks and nose with a light pink blush.
- Fill in eyebrows with a pencil or powder that is one or two shades lighter than your eyebrow hair. If you have dark and full eyebrows, skip the eyebrow step.
- Brush eyelashes with a brown or black mascara.
- Use a light pink or nude lip colour

Tools Needed

- Brushes ranging in sizes
- Concealer
- Contour
- Eyebrow gel/powder/pencil
- Lipstick/gloss
- Foundation
- Mascara

How to look Masc

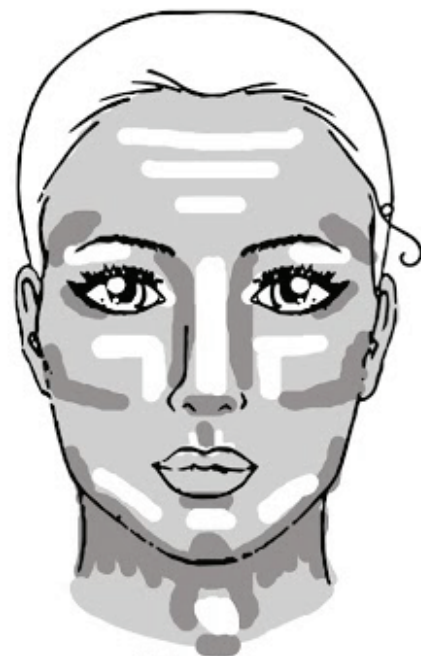
- Contour with a shade two to three shades darker than your skin across your jaw, chin, eyebrow bone, nose, cheeks, and temples.

To make the face look more sharp rather than soft.

- Fill in eyebrows with a pencil or powder that is one or two shades lighter than your eyebrow hair. If you have dark and full eyebrows, skip the eyebrow step.
- If you have peach fuzz around your mouth or where sideburns would grow, repeat the same as the eye brows and blend lightly with a spoolie.
- **Optional:** Theatre supply and Halloween stores sell fake facial hair that can easily be applied with spirit gum. Instructions for application will come with the product itself.

Tools Needed

- Brushes ranging in size
- Concealer
- Contour
- Eyebrow gel/powder/pencil
- Foundation



Masc Contour

Basic "blank" face

- Lightly conceal any red spots or acne
- Fill in eyebrows with a pencil or powder that is one or two shades lighter than your eyebrow hair
- Brush eyelashes with clear mascara
